

IES Application Form 2018: Union Public Service has released the application form for Indian Engineering Services (IES) online on September 27, 2017. The IES application form is available online and the aspirants can apply online until October 23, 2017. Applicants should fill IES application form 2018 online since no other mode of applications will be accepted by exam conducting body, UPSC. The IES application fees is Rs.200/- for General and OBC category candidates while female/SC/ST/PH candidates need not to pay any fee. The application fees of IES can be paid in both online and offline mode. The online application form of IES can be filled in two parts – Part 1 registration and Part 2 payment of fees, uploading of scanned images of photograph and signature and final submission.

Applicants should check the eligibility conditions prescribed by UPSC before filling the online IES application form. As per the eligibility conditions, applicants should be an Indian/Nepalese/ Bhutanese/ Tibetan Refugee who came to India before 1 January 1962 to settle in India or a person of Indian origin who migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania (Formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar), Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia and Vietnam to settle in India. Applicants should have qualified graduation or in the final year of in any of the mentioned discipline and be in the age group of 21-30 years. IES 2018 Application Form Dates

The application of Indian Engineering Services (IES) began on September 27. The IES 2018 exam will be conducted in three phases – Preliminary, Mains and Personality Test. The Preliminary exam of **IES 2018** is scheduled to be conducted on January 7, 2018 followed by Mains exam and Personality Test. For IES 2018 application form dates, candidates can check the table below.

How to fill IES Application Form 2018?

The online IES 2018 application form is spread over different sections involving filling up of details such as Personal Profile, Contact detail, Age Relaxation, Fee Exemption, Educational Qualification, Experience etc. Details can be filled in multi-session after registration. Applicants should fill all the details as asked in the application form since applications with incomplete information will be rejected. Candidates can check below 'how to fill IES application form 2018'.

Part 1 Registration

This is the first step of IES application form 2018. Applicants in this part need to enter their name, parents name, gender, place of birth, name of the state, nationality, email address, password and mobile number. Check below for more details.

Name: Candidates should enter their name as recorded in the Matriculation/Secondary Examination Certificate. They should not prefix such as Shri/ Mr./ Ms./ Dr./ Mrs. Etc.

Parents name: Candidates should not prefix Shri/ Mr./ Dr etc while entering their parents name.

Gender: Both male and female candidates can apply for IES 2018 application form.

Date of birth: DOB should be entered as recorded in the Matriculation/10th Standard or equivalent certificate. In case, where Date of Birth is not available in certificate/mark sheets, issued by concerned Educational Boards, DOB as indicated in School leaving certificate will be considered.

Nationality: All candidates, except Citizen of India, will be required to produce certificate of eligibility issued by the Government of India.

Email address: Enter e-mail address which is current and active.

Password: Please choose maximum 10 digit and minimum 8 digit password which will be required each time while logging. Password must contain atleast one character one number

Mobile number: Candidates must note that all the communication from UPSC will be made on the mobile number entered by them.

Candidates after all entering all details should click on 'Save and Continue' button. The registration number and password will be displayed on the screen. The candidate will also be intimated that they have completed Part-I Registration of Online Application procedure. An email message would be sent to the registered e-mail id of the applicant regarding completion of PART-I and advising him to complete PART-II of the application. Applicants should take a print out of this page by clicking on the print option.

Part 2 Registration

To fill IES 2018 Part 2 application form, candidates will have to login with their registration ID and date of birth. The Part 2 registration comprises of three steps:

- Fee payment
- Choice of examination centre
- Uploading of scanned images of photograph and signature.

Fee payment:

Candidates have three options of payments - 'Pay by Cash' by depositing cash at any branch of State Bank of India through pay-in-slip generated during Part II registration, 'Pay by Card' through any Visa/Master card/Rupay debit/credit card and through net banking. The application fee for general and OBC category candidates is Rs 200 while women candidates, SC, ST & PH candidates need to pay any application fees.

Uploading of images of photograph and signature

Candidates are required to upload the images of recent photograph and signature as per given dimension. Images to be uploaded should be only in .jpg format. The file size should not exceed 40 KB each and must not be less than 3 KB in size for the photograph and 1 KB for the signature. The

pixel size of photograph should be 140 pixels height x 110 pixels width while the signature should be 110 pixels height x 140 pixels width.

Choice of examination centre:

The system asks for the location preferences for the recruitment test centers. Here, candidates are required to select two preferences for IES 2018 exam. Candidates will have to select the [exam centres](#) from the drop down menu.

Applicants should submit the application form after completing Part 2 registration using I agree button. An e-mail message would be sent to the registered e-mail id of the applicant when the final submission of the application is completed.

IES 2018 Eligibility Criteria

Candidates before applying should ensure that they fulfill the [IES eligibility criteria](#) in terms of age, educational qualification and nationality. Applicants should have attained the age of 21 years and must not have attained the age of 30 years. Graduation in engineering is mandatory for applying to IES exam.

Highlights of IES Application Form 2018

- The application form should filled in online mode only.
- Applicants should avoid submitting multiple applications.
- Candidates must fulfill the eligibility criteria.
- Applicants should read the instructions carefully before filling the applications form.
- Candidates should complete both Part 1 and Part 2 IES application form.
- The applicants must ensure that while filling their application form, they are providing their valid and active e?mail Ids.
- Candidates should submit the application form after ensuring that all the informations entered by them are authentic.
- No editing of IES application form 2018 will be entertained after final submission.

IES 2018: Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) has released IES 2018 notification on September 27, 2017. The commission has announced a total of 588 vacancies for various departments under Civil, Mechanical, Electrical and Electronics and Telecommunication engineering disciplines. The application form has been released online and aspirants can submit their applications through the same mode. The IES 2018 exam will be conducted in three phases – Preliminary, Mains and Personality test . As per UPSC exam calendar 2018, the Preliminary exam of IES is scheduled to be conducted on January 7, 2018 followed by mains examination on July 7, 2018. The dates of Personality Test will be informed after the declaration of result of mains exam. Marks obtained by candidates in all the three stages will be considered for final merit list. Candidates will be allotted to the various services keeping in view their ranks in the exam and preferences of posts. Candidates should be between 21 to 30 years and must be a graduate in Engineering. Candidates can check below for IES 2018 eligibility criteria, exam dates, application, selection procedure, vacancy details, exam pattern and syllabus.

IES 2018 Vacancies

UPSC has announced 588 vacancies under Civil, Electrical, Mechanical and Electronics and Telecommunication engineering. Out of 588 total vacancies, 18 are for PH candidates (LDCEP?15 & HI?03) vacancies. The number of vacancies is liable to alteration. Reservations will be made for

candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes and Physically Disabled Category in respect of vacancies as may be fixed by the Government of India.

UPSC released IES 2018 notification on September 27, 2017. The application form began along with the official notification. IES Eligibility Criteria 2018

The eligibility criteria of IES gives details about the eligibility requirement set by UPSC for candidates interested in applying for the exam. The IES eligibility criteria includes nationality, academic qualification and age limit. Candidates to be eligible for the exam must fulfill the IES eligibility criteria 2018. Candidates can check below for IES eligibility criteria.

Academic qualification: At least a bachelor's degree in Engineering (B.E. / B. Tech) from a recognised university or equivalent. M.Sc degree or its equivalent with Wireless Communications, Electronics, Radio Physics or Radio Engineering as special subjects are acceptable for certain services / posts only.

Age Limit: Candidates should be between 21 to 30 years.

Nationality: Indian/Nepalese/ Bhutanese/ Tibetan Refugee who came to India before 1 January 1962 to settle in India or a person of Indian origin who migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania (Formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar), Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia and Vietnam to settle in India.

IES Application Form 2018

The application form of IES 2018 has been released on September 27, 2017. The last date to fill IES application form is October 23, 2017. Candidates need to fill the application form online. The

application fee for IES 2018 is Rs 200 for General and OBC category candidates and women/SC/ST/ PH need not to pay any fees. The application fee can be paid either through offline or online mode. The IES application form 2018 can be filled in two parts – Part 1 Registration and Part 2 Registration. The steps to fill IES application form is given below.

Part 1 Registration

In Part I registration, candidate will have to fill basic information such as personal details, academic qualification, address, email ID, contact number etc.

Part 2 Registration

In Part 2, candidates will have to pay application fees, select centres, upload photograph and signature and agree to declaration.

IES Exam Cities 2018

UPSC will release the list of IES exam cities along with the notification. Candidates should enter their choice of examination centre while filling the online application form. Candidates will be allotted exam cities on first-apply-first-allot basis. The exam cities of IES prelims and mains are different.

IES Admit Card 2018

The admit card of IES prelims exam will be released in the last week of December 2017. The admit cards will be released for only those candidates whose applications will be accepted by examination authority. The IES admit card will be available online and candidates can access their admit cards through the link provided on this page. Candidates can download IES Admit Card 2018 by entering either their roll number/registration number and date of birth. The IES admit card 2018 for mains exam will be released in mid of June 2018 for only those candidates who will qualify the prelims exam.

IES Exam Pattern 2018

The exam pattern of IES gives details about the marking scheme, stages of examination, mode of exam, number of questions, number of sections and total marks. The IES exam is conducted in three phases – Preliminary, Mains and Personality Test. The preliminary examination as per IES exam pattern 2018 consists of objective type questions. The exam will comprise of two papers – Paper I General Studies and Engineering Aptitude and Paper 2 Engineering discipline specific paper. The maximum marks allotted to Preliminary exam is 500 marks. The IES mains exam will consist of two conventional type papers on engineering discipline. The total marks of IES mains exam is 600. The Personality Test will carry 200 marks. Candidates can check the exam pattern of IES below.

The syllabus of IES for both preliminary and mains examination has been defined by UPSC. The IES syllabus of engineering specific discipline has been framed as per the curriculum of engineering degree examination of an Indian University. The standard of paper of General Studies and Engineering Aptitude will be basically of an Engineering/Science Graduate level. Candidates should be thorough with the syllabus of IES for better preparation. Read more on IES syllabus through the link given above.

Candidates can download here the sample papers of IES 2018. The IES sample papers will give the candidates an fair idea of the paper pattern, difficulty level, topic-wise distribution of questions, marks distribution etc. The sample papers will help candidates to enhance their problem solving ability and boost up their speed. Candidates should solve the sample papers regularly to prepare for the exam in a better way. Solving the sample papers, candidates can identify their weak areas, thus, enabling them to focus on those areas.

[IES Answer Key 2018](#)

The answer key of IES Preliminary examination will be released by coaching institutes after the completion of exam on January 7, 2018. Candidates can download here IES answer key for all sets of question booklets – A, B, C, D. Candidates who will appear in the exam can check correct answers to General Studies and Engineering Aptitude and Engineering Specific discipline. Candidates based on correct and incorrect answers can calculate their probable score. UPSC will release official IES answer key of preliminary exam after the completion of recruitment process.

[IES Result 2018](#)

The result of IES will be released by examination authority in three phases – Preliminary, Mains and Final. At the first stage, the IES result of preliminary exam will be declared followed by mains and final result. The commission will release IES result 2018 of prelims will be declared in March/April 2018. Candidates on the basis of their marks in preliminary exam will be selected for mains exam. The number of candidates to be selected for mains examination will be about six to seven times the total approximate number of vacancies. The result of IES mains exam will be announced September/October. Candidates twice the number of vacancies will be called for personality test. The final result of IES will be declared on the basis of the marks obtained by candidates in Preliminary exam, Mains exam and Personality Test. The commission will decide the ranks of candidates under each category on the basis of their performance in all the three stages.

IES Cutoff 2018

The cutoff of IES is the minimum marks required to qualify the exam and become eligible for next stage of selection procedure. Candidates on the basis of the IES cutoff of written stage will be selected for Personality Test. The commission will decide IES cutoff for preliminary examination out of 500 marks to select candidates for mains examination. Similarly, UPSC will decide cutoff score in mains examination out of 600 marks. Based on IES cutoff 2017 of prelims and mains, candidates will be selected for Personality test. The final cutoff of IES will be based on the marks secured by last finally qualified candidates out of 1300 marks. The IES cutoff 2018 for all the stages- Prelims, Mains and Final will be released after declaration of final result. The commission will prepare All India Merit list based on the category-wise and discipline-wise cutoff score. Candidates whose names will feature in the merit list will be given appointment to the various posts.
